



Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002 as amended in 2015

The Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002, as amended, is a United Kingdom Statutory Instrument which states general requirements imposed on employers to protect employees and other persons from the hazards of substances used at work by risk assessment, control of exposure, health surveillance and incident planning. There are also duties on employees to take care of their own exposure to hazardous substances and prohibitions on the import of certain substances.

This awareness course provides an introduction to the topic of COSHH and helps individuals to develop an understanding of what COSHH is and why it is important that it is managed carefully within a workplace environment.
